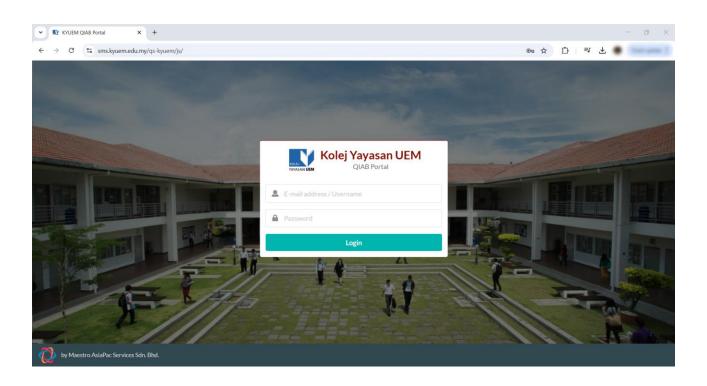

This document provides a user manual for Parents Portal in QIAB system.

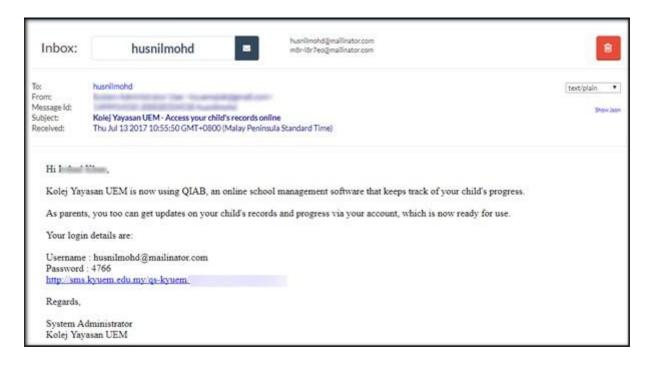

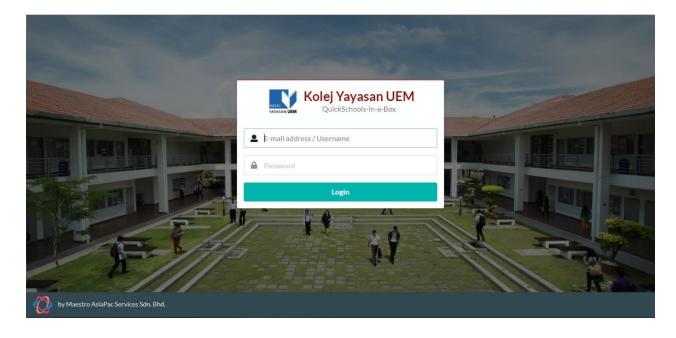


# 3 Parents Portal Login via Computer

- 3. Parents will see the login page as below:

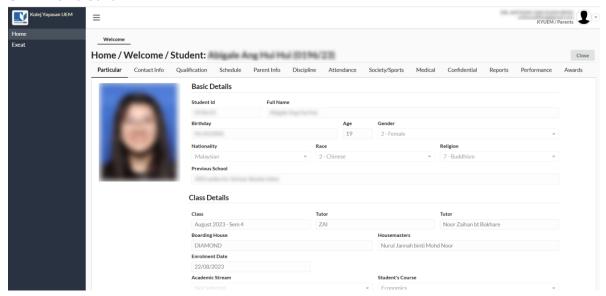


- 4. Enter the username and password as per provided in the invitation email, then press Login.
- 5. Parents will be able to see the Welcome Page in the Parents Portal as below:

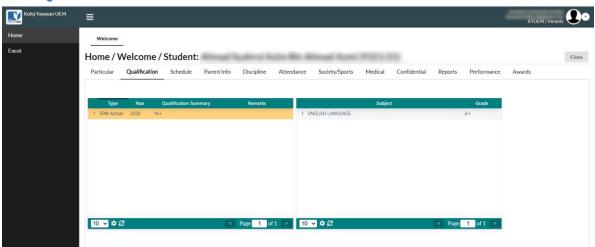


- 6. Click in the Student's Name to view details.

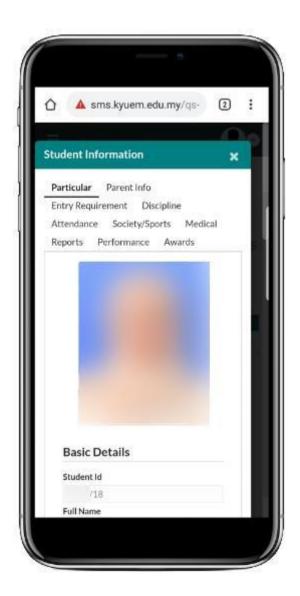


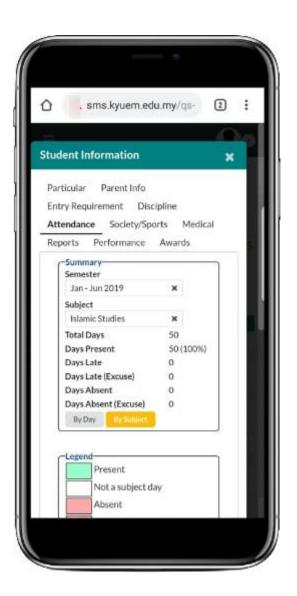
# 4 Parent Portal Login via Mobile

- 3. Parents will be able to see the Parents Portal via mobile phone as per image shown below:







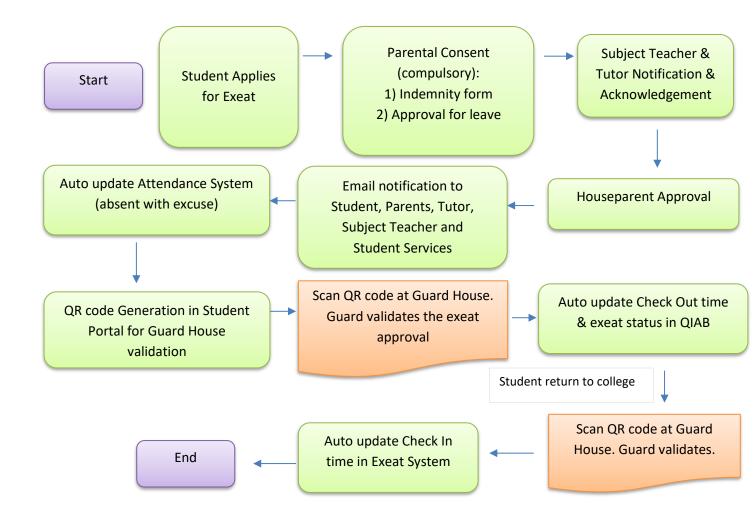


#### 5 Exeat Module

#### **Exeat Module Overview**

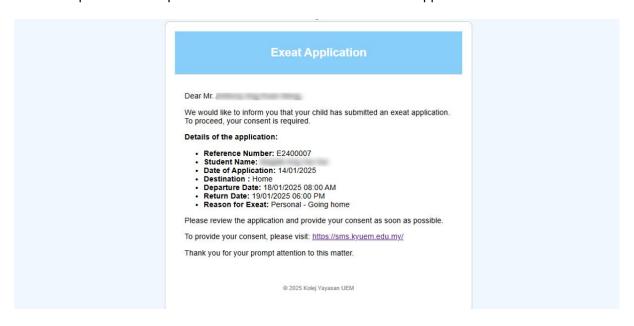
The Exeat Module will serve as a comprehensive solution for managing student leave requests. It will provide students, parents, teachers, houseparents, and administrators with a streamlined workflow to handle exeat applications, approvals, notifications, and QR code-based verification at the guard house.

#### 5.1 Exeat User Manual for Parents

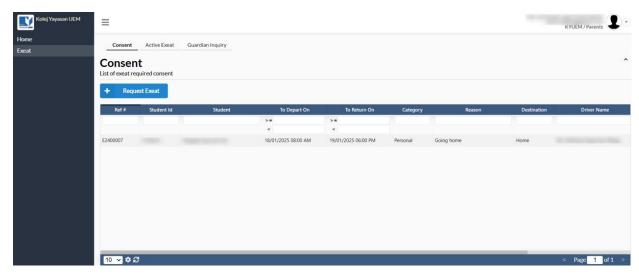
1. Once an exeat application has been submitted by a student, an email notification will be sent to parents. A sample of the email notification for the exeat application as below:



2. Parents can login to QIAB parent portal to proceed with the exeat consent and approval.

#### 5.1.1 Parents - Consent & Approval\*

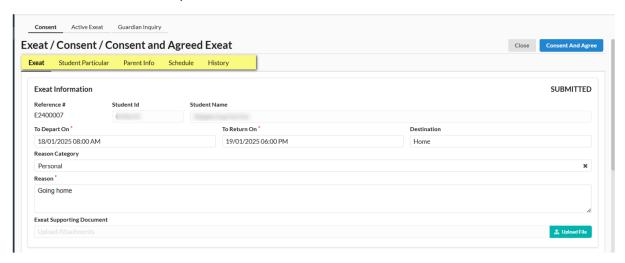
1. Login as parent. Navigate to Exeat > Consent.



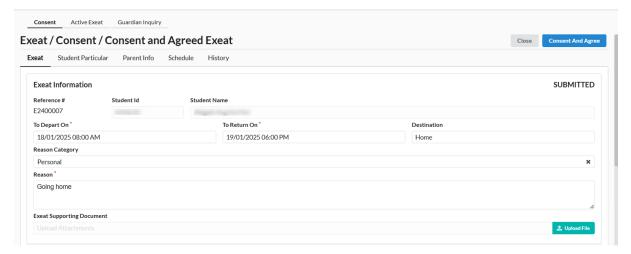
- 2. If the exeat was submitted by the student, parents need to give the consent and approval.
- 3. Login as parents. Navigate to Exeat > Consent. Click on the respective exeat to give consent and approval.



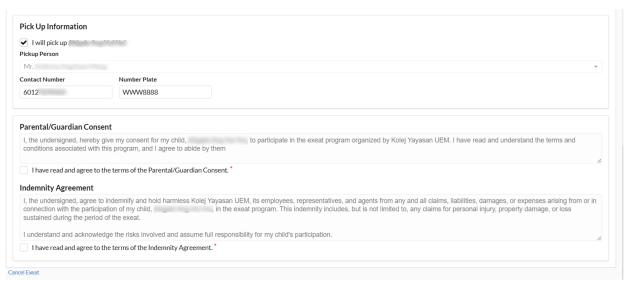
4. User will see multiple tabs under Exeat Consent – Exeat, Student particular, Parent Info, Schedule and History.



- 5. Under Exeat tab, parents can see the form as below, consist of information such as:
  - a. Exeat Information
  - b. Missed Lessons
  - c. Pick Up Information
  - d. Parental/Guardian Consent & Indemnity Agreement



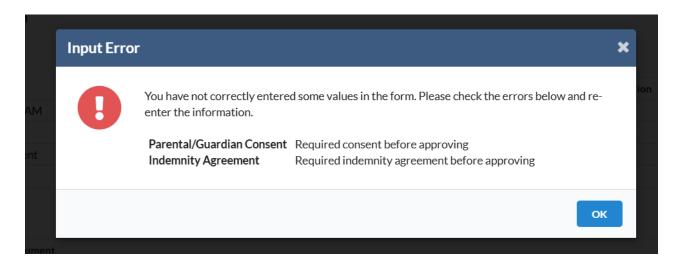




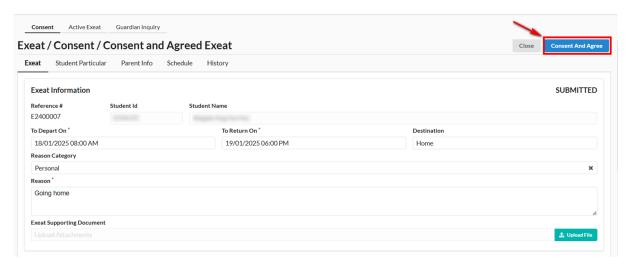
- 6. At the bottom of the page, parents can see 'Cancel Exeat' button, in case parents want to cancel the exeat application by the student.
- 7. The most important part for parents' role is to tick the Parental/Guardian Consent & Indemnity Agreement.



8. If parents are trying to click on Consent and Agree button without ticking both 'I have agreed to the terms of the Parental/Guardian Consent and Indemnity Agreement' as above, system will prompt the input error as below:



9. Once all done, parents can click on the Consent and Agree button at the top right of the page.

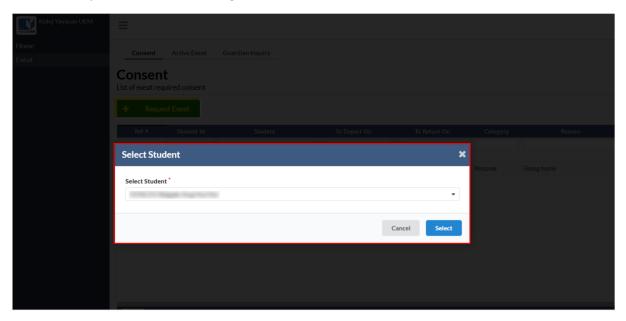


10. Once parents have given consent and agreed, an email notification will be sent to the student, tutor and student service, to notify that the exeat has been consented and agreed indemnity.

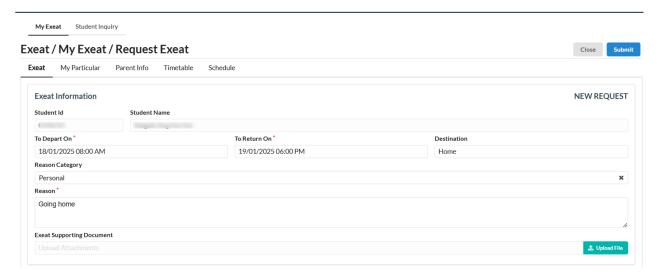
#### 5.1.2 Request Exeat (on behalf of the child)

Parents have the option to request exeat on behalf of their child. Click on the Request Exeat button to do so.

1. **Select Student** - The system will prompt a dialog box to select the student (some parents have multiple children in the college).



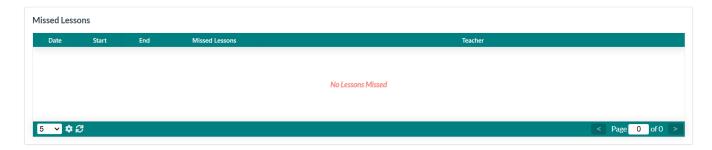
- 2. **Exeat Information** fill in the Exeat Information.
  - a. Depart and Return date\*
  - b. Destination
  - c. Reason Category
  - d. Reason\*
  - e. Attach supporting documentation (if any)



#### 3. Missed Lessons – auto populate

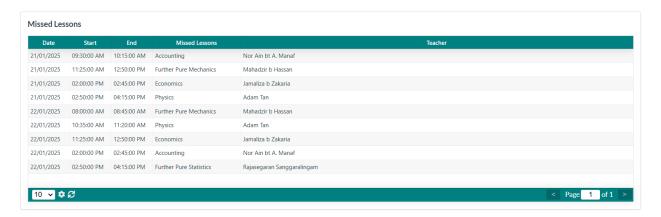
#### a. Weekend Exeat

If the exeat date falls on weekends, this field will be empty.



#### b. Weekday Exeat

If the exeat date falls on weekdays/school days, the system will automatically populate the details of missed classes based on the date and time selected.

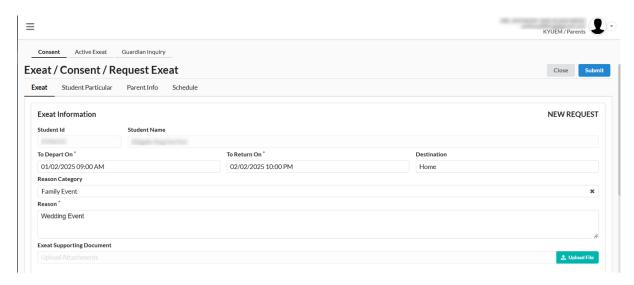


- 4. Pick Up Information Fill in pick up information.
  - a. Pickup Person
  - b. Contact Number
  - c. Plate Number



5. Parental/Guardian Consent and Indemnity Agreement – parents need to read and understand the guardian consent and indemnity agreement. To proceed, parents need to tick to both 'I have agreed to the terms of the Parental/Guardian Consent and Indemnity Agreement'.

6. Once done, click on the Submit button at the top right of the page.



7. Once parents have submitted the exeat form, and email notification will be sent to the student, tutor and student service, to notify that the exeat has been consented and agreed indemnity.
